## Why information do I need to order a Replacement Tarp?

Shur-Co® can accommodate your request for any size **Replacement Tarp**. However, tarps ordered in a standard width are more economical. The usual box width on trucks and trailers is 96 to 102 inches while the X-wide box width on grain carts is 108 to 144 inches. (X-wide tarps are only available in 18-oz. fabric.)

Necessary information to have on hand when you call or place your order online is: 1) the type of tarp system you're fitting, 2) your trailer type, trailer length and trailer width and, most importantly, 3) your current tarp's finished length. We also need to know whether the front-end style is raised, flat, square or radius; whether end caps are galvanized steel, aluminum or fabric; and whether caps are low rise, high rise or flat.

Do you prefer mesh or solid vinyl for your fabric? If water resistance is not an issue, mesh is a lightweight choice that offers circulation plus secure containment.
